Antonio Russo graduated with honor in Medicine in 2003 at the Second University of Study of Campania (SUN) writing a thesis on “Dopaminergic modulation of frontal cortical functions in patients with Parkinson’s disease: a functional magnetic resonance imaging study”. In 2009 he specialized in Neurology at the SUN with a score of 50/50 with honor. In 2009 starts his collaboration in the scientific activity carried out at the “Center of High Magnetic Resonance Studies” of the Second University of studies of Naples (SUN) – Italian Multiple Sclerosis Foundation (FISM); getting, in 2013, doctoral research in experimental pathophysiology and neuroscience with a thesis entitled “BOLD-fMRI studies to elucidate pathophysiological mechanisms in migraine”. At the same time is nominated responsible of the Headache Center at the Hermitage -Capodimonte Institute of Diagnosis and Treatment in Naples from 2010 to 2014. Becoming then responsible of the headache and facial algia center at the first Neurological Clinic of the University of Campania “Luigi Vanvitelli”, of which is still responsible. His professor career started in 2010 as assignment contract professor at the integrated course of Medical Sciences at the University of Studies of Naples Federico II – University faculty of biomedical engineering and also at the Parthenope University of Naples; in the 2014 as Assistant professor of Neurology, with ward clinical activity at first Neurological Clinic of the University of Campania “Luigi Vanvitelli”. In the 2017 win a research grant at the University of the Study of Campania “Luigi Vanvitelli”, until he became an Associate Professor at the University of the Study of Campania “Luigi Vanvitelli” on December 2019, role that is currently covered. From 2006 write more than 140 scientific articles as co-author and author obtaining important awards like “Greppi Award”, international prize for the best scientific research of the year on the topic of headaches (Athens 2019) and the Harold G. Wolff Lecture Award for the best paper on headache in 2020, recognition obtained for the first time by an Italian research group.
